Applications should be signed by an authorized individual. It is recommended that camp participants be students identified in accordance with the State of Ohio Gifted and Talented identification guidelines. High performance may be manifested in any or a combination of these areas:

- Superior Cognitive Ability
- Specific Academic Ability
- Creative Thinking Ability
- Visual or Performing Arts

The daily sessions will begin at 9:00 AM and conclude at 2:50 PM.

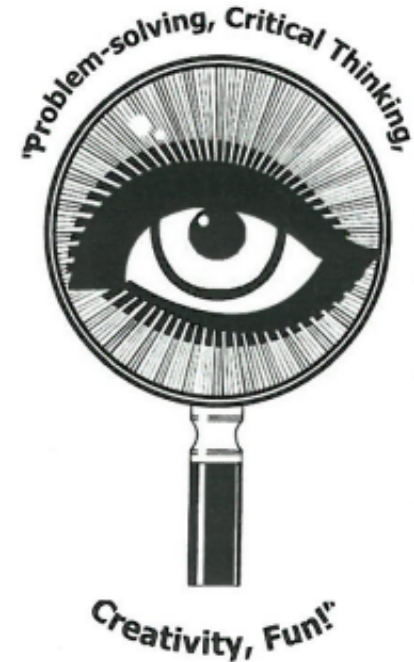

# Camp Inquire

## Recommendations

1.) Applications will be accepted for children who have completed grades 2-6

2.) It is recommended that applicants be students identified as those who perform or show potential for remarkably high levels of accomplishment in at least one of the following:

- Superior Cognitive Ability
- Specific Academic Ability
- Creative Thinking Ability
- Be presently enrolled in the school gifted program
- Recommended by a teacher or other trained professional

3.) School personnel should complete the School Endorsement portion of this application form prior to registration.

4.) **A \$135 non-refundable camp fee is required of all participants.** This fee must be processed at the time of online registration for the submission to be complete.

## Information

1.) The camp fee is \$135 per week. The camp fee is payable at the time of registration online.

2.) The parent/guardian provides transportation. **Camp runs from 9:00 AM - 2:50 PM each day.**

3.) Students are required to bring a packed lunch each day.

4.) There will be approximately 7-10 class options to choose from each week. Some classes are specific to grades 2-3 or 4-6 or may be available on a certain week only. When registering online, students will rank class options in order of preference and they will then be placed in their top 3 options based on availability and roster size. Students are guaranteed to get into 1 of their top 3 choices (*we will do our best to get them in all 3*).

5.) As per policy, no refunds are given for circumstances considered to be "Acts of God."

6.) Strict adherence to selection of the week attending is critical. **No switching of weeks is permitted.**
